All those students who are interested to change their branch must have secured aggregate SGPA ≥ 5.5 in B.Tech. I-Semester Main Examination 2019-20, in all components in one attempt would be eligible to apply. Students are advice to fill the application form provided through email along with the Mark-sheet (Internet Copy). The last date for submission of application form through email along with Mark-sheet (Internet copy) of B.Tech First Semester is Saturday July 4, 2020. The payment for the branch change process is Rs. 600/- for each student. The list of eligible students for branch change process is attached with the email; only the eligible students can apply for branch change if they wish to do so.

Any change in rule by RTU in near future for branch change will also be inculcated.
